

DCFU Treasurers Report 2019/20

This year started off well as usual with entries coming in and most of the competitions taking place before county events including the Excalibur were finally curtailed in March.

Because of this, and reduced entry numbers and increased hall costs, overall the county hasn't managed to generate as much surplus this year.

The DCFU opening balance in April last year was £3728.54 and currently stands at £3812.91.

While this might be slightly disappointing compared to previous years, I don't think it's too bad considering the current circumstances.

Note the amount paid to Jim, this was for various bits and pieces owed to him for which he has provided all information. I just need to give myself more time to break it down, apologies for this, I will issue an updated balance summary when I have completed it.

Moving forward, I suggest DCFU funds could be used in some way to kickstart fencing in the county after the pandemic. Possibilities are, providing funds for coach training, running competitions at a reduced price. All subject to committee approval of course.
